NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Bayan, to strongly urge and recommend that:






1. All public schools and hospitals to conduct a comprehensive structural integrity evaluation of their buildings within the one (1) year from the adoption of this Resolution;
2. Such evaluation be conducted by licensed structural engineers or accredited engineering firms in accordance with the National Building Code and other relevant engineering standards;
3. Institutions found structurally sound be issued a Certificate of Structural Soundness valid for a period of fifteen (15) years;
4. Building found deficient or unsafe be prioritized for retrofitting or reconstruction to comply with safety standards; and
5. The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of Health (DOH), be encouraged to develop and implement guidelines for monitoring and reporting compliance with this Resolution.






